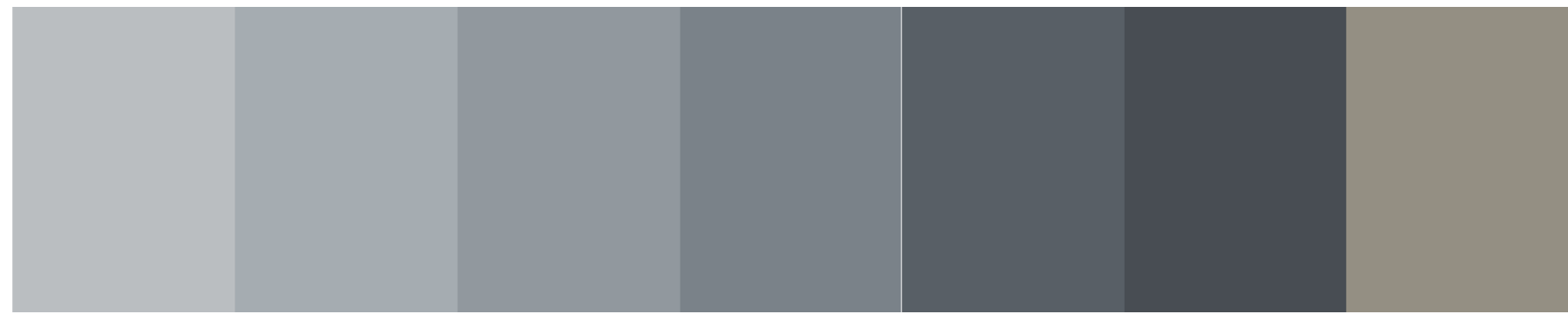

COLOUR HINT:

Colour was used here to refresh this building but it was used only to highlight rather than encapsulate the area. It was important to consider the local surrounds so remember to select colours that are complimentary to the immediate area and landscape.

Protecting the design:

- The complex is built on a floating platform of steel and concrete
- The existing colours were dated and typical of 2000's
- Combination of cream exterior walls with Titania Joinery and plywood garage doors
- Use of Titan board and weatherboard on the top sections of the apartments created a top heavy look
- The selected colour pallet was shades of Grey from the Dulux World of Colour Atlas
- Using five shades of Grey the Titan board on each block was graduated from Dark to Light
- Complementing the Titan board with lighter coloured weatherboards gave more proportion to the apartment blocks
- Splashes of colour to garage and front doors were added to create a vibrancy to the environment
